Dining Room Trash Collection



Step 1...

Bring dedicated, blue Pack-A-Drum[®] trash collection container to first trash enclosure with cleaning chemicals in the Cleaning Accessories Caddy and 4 – 5 standard dining room trash bags on handle.



Step 2...

Remove trash from trash enclosure and place directly inside blue container to avoid any potential spills onto the floor. DO NOT tie the bags as you place them in the blue container.



Step 3...


Remove trash bag from handle and replace the bag in the dining room receptacle. Clean area around trash enclosure, and move on to the next receptacle. Repeat process until the Pack-A-Drum[®] blue trash collection container is full. Then, roll the full container back to the Pack-A-Drum[®] trash deflator.




Deflating the Trash













Step 1... Lining the Pack-A-Drum®

- ...Tear a bag off of the roll and place in the Pack-A-Drum® barrel.
- ...Pull bag over left bag catch.
- ...Pull bag over right side.
- ...Lift handle and pull bag over latch holder.

Push handle through bag, and into latch holder, to hold in place.

Step 2...Preparing Trash

Open trash bags prior to placing in deflator and remove trays when found. If bags are tied, rip a hole in the bag to allow air to escape.

Deflating the Trash





Step 3...Loading Trash

Load bags to top of the Pack-A-Drum® Barrel.



Step 4...Loading Trash

Close Top until it stops.



Step 5...Deflating Trash

Stand in front of deflator and pull wheel towards your body, hand over hand, until the wheel can no longer be turned (stamp will be about half way down the barrel). The wheel may become difficult to turn if an air bubble develops in the bags during deflation.

Deflating the Trash



Step 5...Deflating Trash (cont.)

If a bag bubbles during deflation, hold the wheel in place with right hand, and reach in with left to rip a whole in the bag. This will release the air and allow the wheel to turn more easily.



Step 6...Wheel Return

Once the wheel is turned as far as it will go, do not let go. Keep both hands on wheel to slow the speed of return. The trash stamp will return to the top of the barrel.



Step 7...Reload

Push deflator top open and load more trash. Repeat steps 3 thru 6. Please do not deflate more than 4 bags total in any one liner, as bags tend to get heavy when over-compacted.

Trash Staging and Removal



Step 8...Breaking Down Boxes

Break down all boxes and place flat on the transport cart.



Step 9...Removing Filled Bag from Pack-A-Drum®

Lift handle to unlatch and open door of Pack-A-Drum[®]. Open door and tie bag.



Step 10...

Place full bag on the platform cart on its side for future removal. It is also a good idea to re-line the Pack-A-Drum[®] barrel at this time, as defined in "Step 1", to eliminate the need to do this step during the next cycle.



After you have repeated the entire process twice more, and you have 3 full Pack-A-Drum[®] bags on the cart, remove trash and boxes to the dumpster.

LUBRICATE TURNING POINT AND 4 WHEELS WITH 3 IN 1 OIL EVERY 6 MONTHS





LUBRICATE SHAFT AND TEETH WITH WHITE LITHIUM GREASE EVERY 6 MONTHS

The Deflator was designed with low maintenance in mind, but you must <u>Lubricate</u>!
